- What:** 2018 Summer Explorer Academy
- When:** Saturday, August 4<sup>th</sup> – Saturday, August 11<sup>th</sup>
- Where:** University of California San Diego

- Time:** Registration will begin at 0900 hours. During the course of the Academy, daily activities will begin at 0600 hours and end at approximately 2200 hours.
- Attire:** Posts will register in jeans, department polo or T-shirts, and tennis shoes with socks. Post must have a uniform appearance. **DO NOT show up in Class A or B uniform for registration.** Participants must meet grooming (hair, nails, etc.) standards in accordance with their respective department's grooming policy standards. **Class A** uniforms will be required for graduation. Explorers may bring casual attire or an academy appropriate outfit for the BBQ.
- Housing:** UCSD campus (Directions to follow)
- Parking:** **All, non-E-Plated, vehicles parked on campus MUST have a parking permit.** Permits should be purchased prior to arrival and cost \$40 per vehicle; plate number required. There is no grace period for parking. The Watch Commander will assign parking during check-in.
- Cost:** The registration fee is **\$460.00 per person (Explorers and Advisors)**; this includes food, lodging, academy uniforms, instruction, and all classroom material. **A \$230.00 per person deposit is due no later than May 31, 2018. The remaining balance (\$230 pp) is due NO LATER THAN June 29, 2018. NO exceptions.** SDCLEEEAA is required to pay upfront costs prior to the start of the Academy. Please contact the Academy Director if your department requires an exception due to fiscal year.
- Dining:** Explorers with food allergies and/or dietary restrictions **MUST complete and submit Attachment E no less than 45 days before the academy.** UCSD cafeteria staff will provide meal service and dining is included in the cost of the Academy. **Please ensure your Explorers have eaten breakfast prior to registration.** All registered Explorers will

receive their first meal during lunch food service on Saturday, August 4<sup>th</sup>. All registered Explorers will receive three meals a day, Monday – Friday. The last meal served will be breakfast on Saturday, August 11<sup>th</sup>.

**\*\*\*On Friday August 10, 2018, SDCLEEEAA will be hosting a BBQ for the Explorers. Chief of Police and Command Staff are invited to attend.\*\*\***

**Weather Forecast:** Daytime – mid 90s, bright sunshine. Sunscreen is highly recommended. Evenings 70-80s, a light jacket is recommended for evenings.

**Directions:** **9500 Gilman Dr., La Jolla, CA 92093**

**Smoking:** Smoking is not permitted in any dormitory, classroom, meeting rooms, and dining areas. Please obey designated smoking area.

**Alcohol:** Due to our group youth status, **alcohol is not permitted on this campus by anyone involved with our program including advisors.** Anyone in possession of alcohol will be subject to dismissal from the Academy.

**Quiet Hour:** The campus observes quiet time from 2200 hrs to 0600 hrs.

**Graduation:** The graduation will be held on Saturday, August 11, 2018 at 1000 hours at UCSD.

**Checkout:** Advisors and Explorers will check out on Saturday, August 11<sup>th</sup> at 0800 hours. The University will provide a secure facility for luggage storage during graduation. UCSD staff will inspect rooms during the checkout procedure for inventory and property damage. SDCLEEEAA will bill your police agency for missing or damaged property.

**Prior to arrival:** **COMPLETED Registration and Medical forms MUST be submitted via email or by mail no later than July 13, 2018.** Final payment must have been received prior to arrival. Advisors must review and acknowledge academy rules, regulations, and expectations for Explorers and Advisors; including the Physical Assessment requirement for completion.

**What not to bring:** Leave all your valuables at home. SDCLEEEAA is not responsible for lost or stolen property. No electronic equipment will be permitted; this includes, and is not limited to the following: iPods,

iPads, Netbooks, Laptops, MP3 players, video games, digital recorders of any kind, cameras, cell phones and any digital recording devices. These items may be retained by the Advisor(s) of the respective Post and released to the Explorers when permitted by the Academy Director(s) and/or the Phase Coordinators. NO EXCEPTIONS. Please see rules for further explanations.

**What to bring:** Every participant must bring **their own toiletries, bedding (sleeping bag/blanket/sheets) and towels.** In the event an Explorer or Adviser forgets sleeping bags or towels, a \$ 6.00/PER DAY charge will be due at check-in. If SDCLEAA or UCSD are unable to provide these accommodations, the Advisor responsible for the Explorer will need to supply bedding and towels for the duration of the Academy.

**All Academy Explorers are required to obtain a Medical evaluation and a release signed by a physician *PRIOR* to arrival at the academy.**

**This form will be included in the packet you receive; this is the only form the Academy will accept. Old forms and school related forms are not valid and will not be accepted.**
